

The Garden Club of Celebration Scholarship

One or more scholarships will be awarded to Celebration High School seniors, or to high school seniors who are residents of Celebration attending another school. The scholarship check will be paid to the place of higher education the student will be attending in the name of that student. The funds may be applied to tuition, educational fees, or books. Emphasis is placed on volunteerism and school/community involvement in relevant fields of interest to the Garden Club's mission.

Criteria: The Garden Club of Celebration scholarship recipient will be a student with plans to pursue a degree in a science related field. Preference in selection of recipient will be given to students who:

- have a strong interest in environmental science, horticulture or related sciences.
- are involved in clubs or programs related to these fields of interest.
- participated in science fair projects related to environmental sciences.

Deadline: March 1

Eligibility: To be eligible for The Garden Club of Celebration Scholarship, the student must meet the following:

- Graduating from High School in this academic year
- Earning a minimum of a 3.0 GPA
- Planning to attend an accredited university or college in the fall following high school graduation

Application:

- Typed or neatly printed

- Completed applications may also be returned to the Celebration High School College & Career Counselor.
